



Welcome to Bear Lake Campground!

We hope that your stay here will be enjoyable. In order that your stay may be pleasant, here are a few of the rules to be observed so all campers may enjoy themselves.

- 1. All vehicles must stop, register, and obtain a pass before entering Bear Lake Campground. You are renting a privilege to stay on our Private Property. If that privilege is abused, you will be asked to leave.
- 2. Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. please observe them, they will be enforced. All minor children must be at their site by 11:00 p.m. Please be considerate of your fellow campers, your taste of music may not be the same as your neighbors, so please keep your radios at a reasonable level. No fireworks In campground!
- 3. **Speed limit Is 10 MPH**. Please drive carefully and watch for children.
- 4. No drunkenness or profanity will be tolerated. You will only be warned once. Those offending will be evicted from their campsite. There will be no refunds!
- 5. Day visitors will be charged \$2.00 per adult. You are responsible for all your visitors. Your visitors must leave campground by 11:00 p.m. If staying overnight they will be charged regular site fees.
- 6. Pets must be on a leash and controlled. Please clean up after pet. Please note -

NO PETS ALLOWED ON THE BEACH!!!

- 7. Campfires are permitted only in the fire rings provided. Please extinguish your campfire when you leave your site or retire for the evening. No fire should be left unattended. Build a campfire not a bonfire. Please no garbage or punching holes in fire rings.
- 8. Please dispose of your garbage and recyclables in the dumpsters located at the main entrance of the campground. Please bag your aluminum cans separately and place them next to the wood barn by the office. If you need more garbage bags please stop at the main office.
- 9. No littering. Please help keep this campground clean.
- 10. All RV's and traveltrailers must dispose of their gray water into the dump station. No draining on or into the ground.
- 11. Help preserve this forest. Do not cut or drive nails into the trees. Firewood sold at office.
- 12. \$100.00 minimum fine for vandalism, stealing or destruction of property. You will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
- 13. No lifeguard is on duty. **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!** Boat, jet ski and wave runner owners, please keep yourself up to date on all the rules and regulations posted at the boat landing.
- 14. Selected State and Local Boating Laws Applicable to Bear Lake:
 - A. State Law
 - · Registration required for motorboats.
 - Wearable life preservers required in boat for each person.
 - Boat lights (red/green combo and white light) after sunset.
 - Observer required in boat plus driver when towing skiers or similar devices.
 - Fishing license required.
 - 14" minimum size limit for bass.
 - Note: See state boating and fishing pamphlets for other laws.
 - B. Local Boating Ordinances
 - Motor boats may operate at a speed faster than slow-no-wake only inside of skizone buoys.
 - Boats **may not** exceed slow-no-wake speed outside of ski zone which includes all shorelines and north end of Bear Lake. Slow-no-wake is the slowest possible speed to maintain steerage.
 - C. Other Local Ordinances
 - No water skiing or towing persons before 11:00 a.m. or after sunset.
 - No water skiing or towing persons in a clockwise direction in skizone.
 Note: See sign at public landing on Bear Lake for complete local ordinance laws.
- 15. Management reserves the right to tell anyone to leave Bear Lake Campground for violation of rules or if problems are caused. There will be no refund!! Management assumes no responsibility for accidents, loss or injury from any cause.
- 16. Absolutely NO FIREWORKS will be tolerated, anyone who disobeys this rule will be asked to leave immediately with no refund.
